**Isolation** is affected by:

Isolation \_\_\_\_\_ for any activity that occurs in a person's home, in buildings that are set off or in rooms that are vacant or private.

**WE WANT TO DECREASE ISOLATION!**

In thinking about **accountability** we need to consider 3 factors:

1. The personal character and integrity of the adult worker. That's

3. The degree of \_\_\_\_\_ associated with an activity. That's why we ask for approval of the activity prior to the event.

**WE WANT TO INCREASE ACCOUNTABILITY!**

Risk increases when there is an imbalance of \_\_\_\_\_ and **control**.

- \*increase the number of adults who are present
- \*change the time or location of the activity
- \*screen the workers and require they obtain approval in advance before sponsoring any activity
- \*maintain a proper age balance between children
